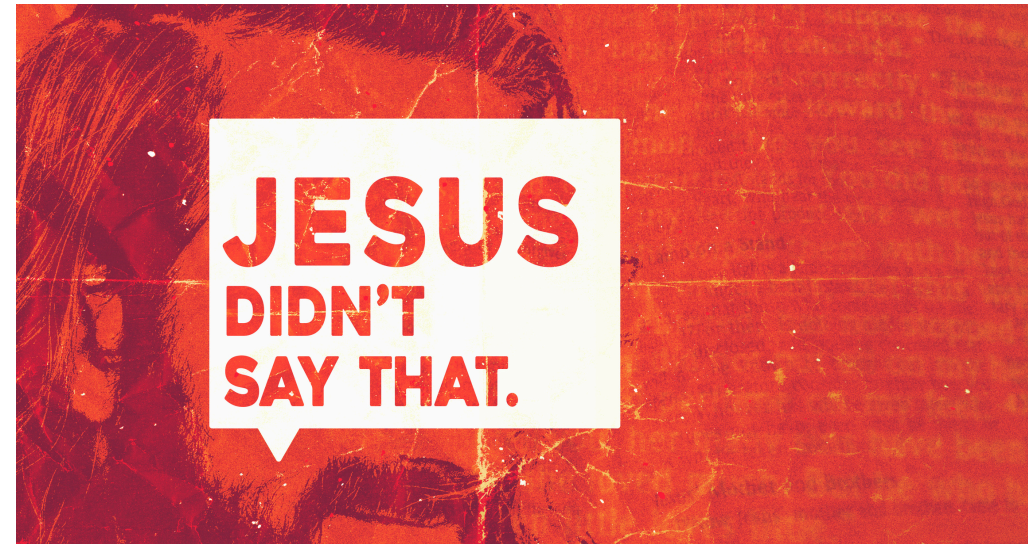
PRAYER
